A Zonta International Program, Funded through the Zonta Foundation for Women

General Information

The world economy continues to leverage and build upon the digital revolution, and industry is becoming critically dependent on information technology. Further, these developments are increasingly disrupting society and familiar social processes. Women, however, are still largely underrepresented in decisions as they relate to information technology and how they impact our world now and into the future. To create a world in which men and women have equal opportunities, women need to have an active role in the field of information technology and access to leadership roles such as chief information officers (CIOs) and chief technology officers (CTOs). Zonta International is pleased to support the Zonta International Women in Technology Scholarship to encourage women to pursue education, career opportunities and leadership roles in information technology.

The Scholarship

The Women in Technology Scholarships are awarded to women of any age and nationality, pursuing an information technology (IT) degree at an accredited university/college/institute, who demonstrate outstanding potential in the field. Online students are also eligible to apply if enrolled at an accredited university/college/institute. Zonta International will offer up to 20 scholarships of US\$8,000 each.

Who is Eligible?

- Women of any age and nationality, pursuing an information technology (IT) degree at an accredited university/college/institute, who demonstrate an outstanding academic record during their academic studies, including information technology subjects. Online students are also eligible to apply if enrolled at an accredited university/college/institute.
- Demonstrated initiative, ambition and commitment to pursuing a career in information technology.
- Enrolled in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a post graduate program at the time the application is submitted.
- Applicants must be in school at the time the scholarship funds are disbursed and must not graduate before April 2022.
- Golden Z club members may apply.
- Classified members and employees of Zonta International and Zonta Foundation for Women, and their family members (ancestors, descendants, adoptees, siblings, nieces or cousins, and those of their spouse or cohabiting partner), are not eligible to apply.

What are the Requirements?

Applicants must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Be enrolled in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a post graduate program at the time the application is submitted. A verification of current enrollment must be submitted with the application. Acceptance letters are not verification of enrollment and will not be accepted.
- Demonstrate a superior academic record at a recognized university or college with accredited courses in information technology (IT) studies as verified by official transcripts and recommendations.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an information technology (IT) degree program by 15 October 2021 and must not graduate before April 2022.

How do I apply?

Applicants may apply for the 2021 Women in Technology Scholarship at <https://zontainternationalwomenintechnology.awardspring.com> and include:

- Zonta International Verification of Current Enrollment form or official statement from the university/college registrar.
- List and include official detailed transcripts of grades or equivalent records from all universities, colleges, or institutions attended, including undergraduate institutions and degrees received. In programs where graduate transcripts are not provided as a matter of institutional policy, please provide a statement of that policy from the registrar or other school official. (**Important note:** please do not upload electronic transcripts, or links to electronic copies directly from the university, as the documents may have expiration dates to review and/or request for a password to access the file. **Please scan official transcripts in color and save as a PDF and upload the saved copy. Please ensure all transcripts are legible.**) **Do not upload unofficial transcripts** as they will not be accepted.
- List and include translated transcripts in English of all grades from all universities, colleges or institutions attended.
- Two confidential recommendations from a faculty member in the major field of study, academic advisor, organization supervisor or volunteer supervisor. Note that a faculty member in the major field of study must be one of the referees. (*Classified members and employees of Zonta International and Zonta Foundation for Women are not eligible to write recommendation letters for applicants.*)
- List scholarships and honors received, if any.
- All non-English documents must be translated into English to be considered.
- Information other than official transcripts and recommendations must be limited to the space provided; attachments, articles, pamphlets, books, curriculum vitae or other publications are not requested and will not be considered.

How are the recipients selected and notified?

The Zonta International Women in Technology Scholarship Committee reviews the applications and recommends recipients to the Zonta International Board. All applicants are evaluated on the criteria stated in the requirements section of the application. All details of the evaluations are kept confidential; evaluations are not disclosed to applicants. All applicants will be notified of their status by February 2022.

How may I use the scholarship funds?

1. The scholarship may be used for any expenses that support the achievement of a degree in information technology (IT) or closely related field.
2. The payment of US\$8,000 is planned for May 2022 subject to any U.S. sanctions regulations.
3. For domestic and foreign recipients studying in the United States, Scholarship funds used for tuition, books, fees, supplies or required equipment for the program of study are not considered taxable income. Withholding taxes may be required on funds used for living expenses or other non-qualified expenses, e.g., room, board or travel to conferences.
4. Recipients are not permitted to defer the Scholarship.
5. Recipients may accept additional grants and scholarships from other sources.

Deadline

The 2021 Zonta International Women in Technology Scholarship application must be submitted **by 15 October 2021** to be considered.
