



# THE IMPACT OF YOUR SUPPORT

We hope you will consider a gift to support Laaha: A Virtual Safe Space for Women and Girls. Below are examples of the impact your gifts could provide:



**\$15** could provide 10 women and girls access to life-saving information on Laaha.



**\$100** could provide 4 women and girls the opportunity to participate in digital literacy training through Laaha's curriculum, covering foundational skills like safe internet navigation, recognizing online abuse, and accessing critical resources for empowerment.



**\$500** could fund a social media or radio campaign, spreading Laaha's life-saving messages to underserved communities and driving meaningful engagement.



**\$2,500** could fund training for local moderators on the Laaha platform, focusing on trauma-informed practices, digital moderation, and conflict-sensitive engagement.



**\$5,000** could provide digital literacy training for 200 women and girls based on the Laaha curriculum covering foundational skills such as safe internet navigation, recognizing and reporting online abuse, and accessing Laaha resources for ongoing support and empowerment.



**\$50,000** could expand Laaha's reach by integrating services with local health and psychosocial support systems, covering outreach and referral networks for up to 5,000 women and girls in remote areas.



**\$80,000** could add an additional language to Laaha to reach a broader audience.
