

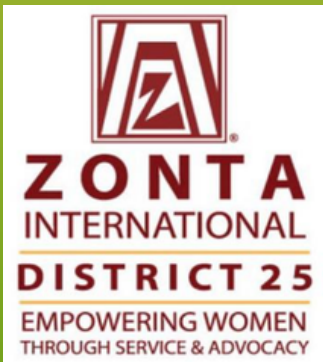

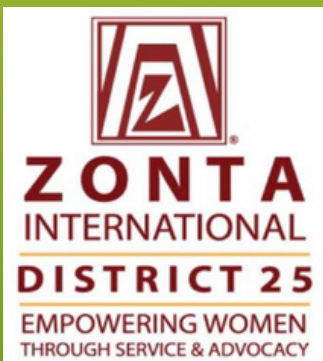

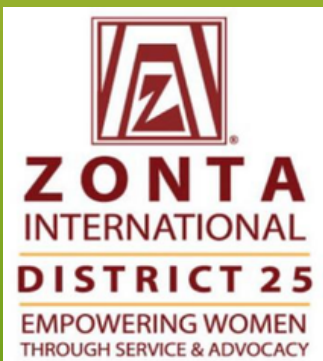
PRESIDENT Z AND YOUTH CLUB OF DHAKA III

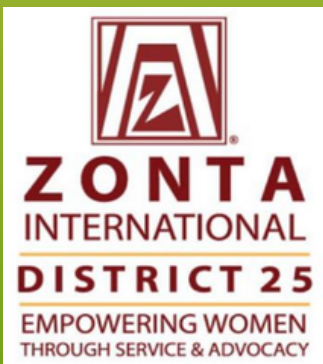

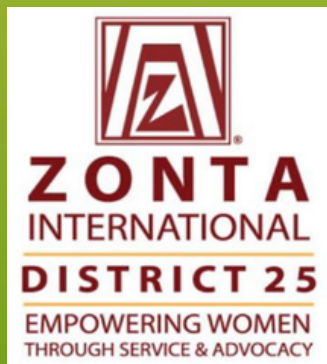
VICE PRESIDENT Z AND YOUTH CLUB OF DHAKA IV
